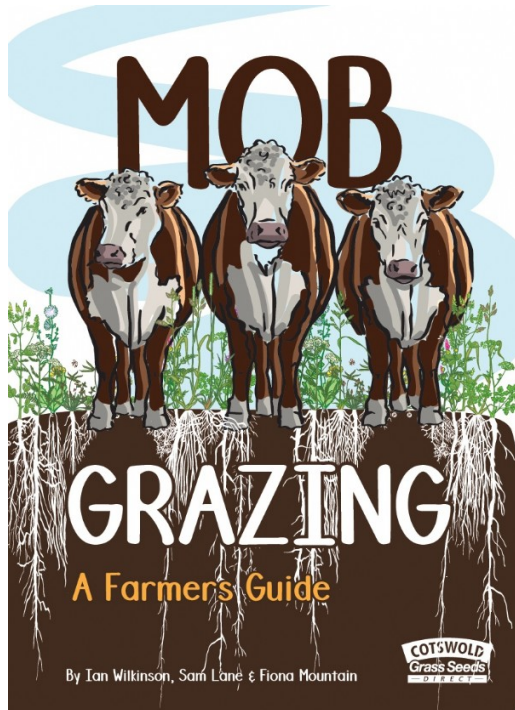


Mob-Grazing Guide
